		Fire sprinklers protected/proper clearance underneath

Okay	Not Okay	Housekeeping/General/Floors/Stairs
		Work areas including aisles/walkways clean, clear and unobstructed
		Trash and debris removed daily or as needed
		Metal cans used for disposing oily or paint soaked debris
		Smoking area designated and away from hazardous operations
		Adequate illumination – Emergency lighting functional
		Wet floors controlled with non-slip material or chemically treated
		Changes in floor elevations marked
		Elevated walkways/Stairs properly guarded with railing

		Adequate M.H. equipment (forklift, handcart, trolley, carts, etc.)
		Policy in place requiring 2 employees to lift heavy or awkward loads
		Employees trained and observed on proper lifting methods
		Storage arranged so heavier items are place on lower and middle shelves
		Stepladder available to retrieve items stored on upper shelves
		Storage of materials arranged to accommodate safe lifting methods
		Storage of materials stacked or arranged neatly/squarely

Okay	Not Okay	Equipment/Machinery/Tools
		Employees properly trained and observed on equipment/machinery/tools
		All moving parts adequately guarded (e.g., flywheels, belts, fans)
		Signs are posted on machines indicating danger, warning, caution
		Bench grinders fully guarded with tool rest, shields and wheel cover
		Equipment and machinery anchored to prevent walking
		Emergency stop buttons accessible and marked
		Lockout procedures are followed during shutdown
		Fan guarding equipped with a full screen having openings 1/2 inch or less
		All cord-connected equipment/tools effectively grounded or insulated
		Equipment/machinery equipped with restart switch for power failure safety

		All circuit breaker panels kept closed
		All circuit breakers marked to indicate their control
		No open spaces or blanks inside circuit breaker panel
		All junction boxes, switches and connection covered
		Electrical connections in wet areas protected with GFCI's
		Limited use of extension cords and only used as temporary wiring
		Extension cords free of defects, insulation damage, no splices
		No storage of flammables near electrical panels or where sparking occurs
		Electrical wiring is protected in conduit or other type of approved raceway

		Paint spray booths cleaned regularly/filters
		Authorized personnel using forklifts only
